We are called to Evangelize, to participate, in the spreading of Jesus' message.

Through our Baptism we are asked to share in the primary mission of the Church, to "Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all Creation."How? Basically we evangelize wherever we find ourselves, by our beliefs, choices, the way we live.

Since the 2nd Vatican Council, the process of evangelization has changed. Instead of meeting for a few private sessions with Father, potential Catholics are prepared to be received into the Church over a period of months through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

For several years, our parish has had an active, life giving RCIA process. This Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a gradual process of initiation that takes place within our very own community. But it depends upon the Faith community. The community both welcomes and nourishes the potential new Catholic.

This ministry of Evangelization is vital. It is one that has been the responsibility of the church through its whole history. And today, each of us is more and more aware of "being Church".

We ask you to think about the people who share your life, in family, neighborhood, friendships and work. Are there people you know who might like to know about the RCIA or who are waiting for you to invite them into the Church community?
